2012/13 to 2013/14 membership figures:

- Whole market: -3.28%
- Clubs where Manager did MDP 1: -1.95%
- Clubs where Manager did MDP 1 & 2: -1.24%
- Clubs where Manager did MDP and club is engaged with business planning and support services: +1.2%

### Impact of our initiatives – More Golfers?



- 400,000 children introduced to golf, but......
- Clubs delivering ClubGolf have 3 times more junior members than those that don't
- 53% of boys and 63% of girls who joined a club did so via the ClubGolf Programme
